2005 POLLUTION PREVENTION (P2) AWARDS

The annual P2 awards honor industrial and commercial dischargers for outstanding multi-media P2 efforts. HRSD recognizes organizations that look beyond traditional treatment, control, and disposal methods and focus on source reduction techniques. Emphasis is placed on wastewater discharges, but other media (air and land) efforts are strongly considered by the judges. Industries are given the opportunity to tell their success stories in their P2 award applications. A panel of five judges reviews the applications to determine the winners in each of the following categories. The winners are:

- GREATER THAN 400,000 GPD

- 25,000 – 400,000 GPD

- LESS THAN 25,000 GPD
